VALNUT PAVILON

- PROVIDES A COVERED AREA
 WITH WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBLE
 PICNIC BENCHES
- NEAR THE SKATE PARK, PLAY AREA, AND SPLASH PAD
- LOCATED ON THE NORTHWEST SIDE OF THE PARK



EDWARDS PAVILON

- PROVIDES A LARGE COVERED AREA WITH PICNIC BENCHES, GRILL, AND ELECTRICAL OUTLETS
- NEAR THE PLAY AREA AND HORSESHOE PITS
- LOCATED ON THE SOUTH END OF THE PARK



ELM PAVILON

- PROVIDES A COVERED AREA
 WITH WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBLE
 PICNIC BENCHES
- NEAR A PLAY AREA, BASKETBALL COURTS
- LOCATED ON THE NORTH EAST END OF THE PARK



ADAMS PAVILON

- PROVIDES A STAGE WITH ELECTRICAL OUTLETS
- NEAR THE BATHROOMS
- LOCATED ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE PARK



SYCAMORE PAVILON

- PROVIDES A COVERED AREA
 WITH WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBLE
 PICNIC BENCHES
- ELECTRICAL OUTLETS & SHADE TREES
- LOCATED NEAR THE
 SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE
 PARK



APPLE PAVILON

- SHADE COVER WITH TWO PICNIC TABLES
- EAST SHADE, CLOSEST TO THE BASKETBALL COURT.
- LOCATED AT THE SPLASH PAD



BIRCH PAVILON

- SHADE COVER WITH TWO PICNIC TABLES
- MIDDLE SHADE
- LOCATED AT THE SPLASH PAD



CHERRY PAVILON

- SHADE COVER WITH TWO PICNIC TABLES
- WEST SHADE, CLOSEST TO SKATE PARK
- LOCATED AT THE SPLASH PAD



Parking:

Park in designated parking areas. No unauthorized vehicles on grass, trails or sidewalks.

Prohibited Items/Activities:

• Camping

• Open Fires

Hunting

- Glass Containers
- Littering
- Horses
- Firearms Alcohol
- Fireworks (except those sponsored by the city) ۲
- Unauthorized cutting or removal of trees or vegetation

Pets:

Must be on a leash at all times. All waste must be removed. Pets are not allowed during Independence Day and Fall Festival activities.
