

RESOLUTION NO. 22-669

CITY OF GENTRY, ARKANSAS

**RESOLUTION APPROVING GRANT-FUNDED PURCHASE
AND INSTALLATION OF COMPUTERS AND RELATED
ITEMS IN PATROL VEHICLES**

WHEREAS, the Gentry Police Department's patrol vehicles are not currently equipped with computers, printers, scanners, and other equipment necessary to participate in the statewide e-Crash/e-Cite systems;

WHEREAS, the City has received approval for a federal grant administered by the Arkansas State Police for this project, on a reimbursable basis, of \$70,700. Of that amount, 90% would be reimbursed by federal funds, and 10% (the Local Portion) would be covered by the Arkansas State Police, as shown in the attached approved e-Crash/e-Cite grant application; and

WHEREAS, the City has obtained updated quotes for the various components and installation (attached), with a total cost (including sales tax) of approximately \$74,848.34; and,

WHEREAS, each component of this project is either under the cost-threshold for competitive bidding, or will be sourced from a provider that has been approved by the Office of State Procurement, in accordance with Arkansas law.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council for the City of Gentry, Arkansas:

Section 1. That the Gentry Police Chief, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute all appropriate agreements and contracts necessary to purchase and install the above-referenced equipment, for a total price not to exceed \$75,000. Purchases exceeding this amount, if any, will be allocated to the departmental Equipment budget.


Section 2. That the City and the Gentry Police Department are authorized to cooperate with the Arkansas State Police as necessary to implement this project and receive the grant funding as set forth in the e-Crash/e-Cite grant approval document.
